

Enjoy **CLEAN, QUIET, FAMILY** camping on any one of our 237 sites, located amidst Cape Cod's famous scrub pines completely surrounded by the **CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE**



Our campground has **hot, metered showers**, four centrally located restrooms, a **laundromat**, and **camp store** (which is open during our peak season.) Each campsite has its own **picnic table** and **parking spot** for one vehicle. Our large **recreation room** is the perfect meeting place with *ping-pong tables, pool tables, foos ball, picnic tables, and a huge fireplace.* We have an outdoor **playground** for children and a separate **adult quiet room** for reading or relaxation.



Directions

Once on Cape Cod, follow Route 6 east to the town of **North Truro** (one town from the end of Cape Cod). Turn **RIGHT** onto Head of the Meadow Road (the Truro Chamber of Commerce will be on the corner). After about one mile turn **LEFT** into North of Highland Camping Area

(if you reach the ocean you have gone 1/2 mile too far).

RESERVATION INFORMATION

FOR RESERVATIONS please call or use the enclosed reservation form. During our peak season (mid-July until mid-August) reservations must be made with arrival and departure dates of a Saturday or Sunday only (6-night minimum). There is a 3-night minimum over July 4th. All other reservations require a 2-night minimum stay. Walk-ins (without reservations) may register for any number of nights pending availability.

DEPOSIT REQUIRED

\$50.00 for the first week or portion thereof.

\$25.00 for each additional week, up to a maximum of \$150.00.

This holds your campsite for 24 hours. The entire period reserved is a firm commitment with the full balance payable upon arrival in either cash, traveler's checks, MasterCard, Visa, or Discover cards.
